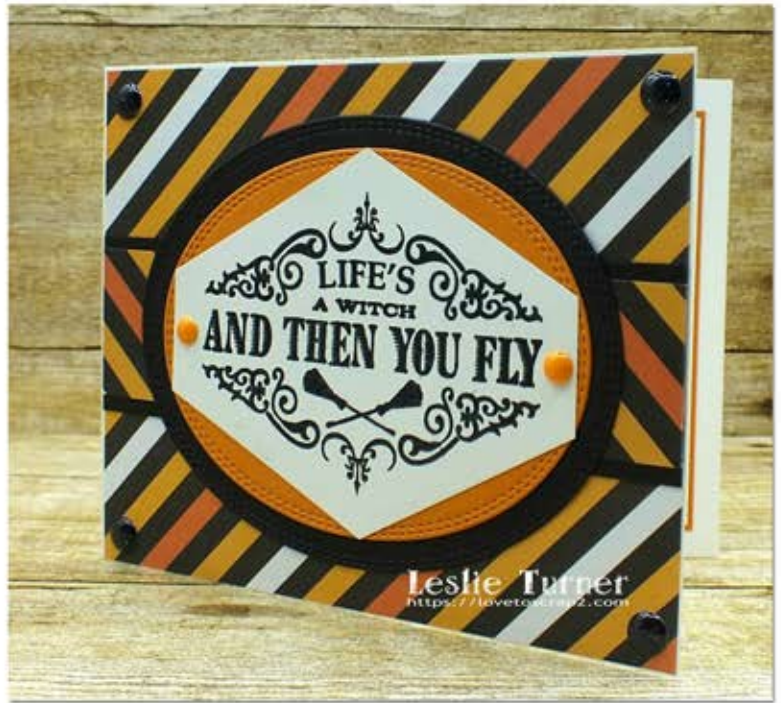




Supplies:

- The Project Bin ‘Haunt It’ stamp set
- MISTI stamp positioner
- Memento Tuxedo Black ink
- Versamark
- Hero Arts Clear embossing powder
- Stampin’ Up Whisper White, Pumpkin Pie and Basic Black cardstock
- The Paper Studio Four Seasons and Everything In Between paper pad
- Cottage Cutz Double-Stitched Ovals die set
- Doodlebug Design Sprinkles Tangerine Assortment
- Your Next Stamp Black Glittered Gumdrops
- ScraPerfect Best Glue Ever



Life’s a Witch, by Leslie Turner

Instructions

Step 1: Cut card base, layers and die cut elements:

- a. Create card base from white cardstock. Side fold created here, 4-1/4” x 11” piece of cardstock, scored at 5-1/2.”
- b. For the front of the card, cut 4-1/4” x 5-1/2” piece of patterned paper for background. Trim 1/32” off two sides so just a tiny bit of white shows around the patterned paper.
- c. Cut 1-1/2” x 5-1/2” strip from black cardstock along with 1-1/4” x 5-1/2” strip from patterned paper. These will layer underneath the oval die cuts.
- d. Cut large oval from black cardstock along with slightly smaller oval from orange cardstock using stitched dies.
- e. Cut 3-3/4” x 3” rectangle from white cardstock. On 3-3/4” side, make light pencil mark at 1-7/8” on the top and bottom (this is the center point). Rotate cardstock to 3” side and make light pencil marks at 1” and 2” on the top and bottom. Cut each corner off from the center point on the long side to the outermost point on each corner. Erase any remaining pencil marks. This will create a cool shape matching the shape of the sentiment.
- f. For the inside of the card, cut 3-5/8” x 4-7/8” panel from white cardstock along with 3-3/4” x 5” layer from orange cardstock.
- g. Cut 5/8” x 3-5/8” strip of patterned paper along with 1/8” x 3-5/8” strip from orange cardstock and 1/4” x 3-5/8” strip from black cardstock. These will be used to embellish the inside panel.

Step 2: Stamp front focal image and inside sentiment, and adhere layers and elements:

- Stamp front focal image on the angled shape. Heat embossing used here. I stamped the front focal image in black ink and once again in Versamark over top the black ink, then applied clear embossing powder and heat embossed it. This is a great trick I learned a long time ago to get virtually any color of embossing!
- Adhere layered strip across center of background panel.
- Stamp inside sentiment on white panel.
- Adhere patterned paper strip and thin cardstock strips on the left side of the inside panel.
- Adhere white embellished panel onto orange layer.



Step 3: Adhere panels to card base and add bling:

- Adhere background panel to front of card base.
- Adhere focal image element to center of card front.
- Add orange bling to sides of focal image element and black glittered bling to corners of card front.
