**Instructions**

**Step 1:** Cut card base and layers:

- Create card base from dark gray cardstock. Standard A2 top fold created here, 4-1/4" x 11" piece of cardstock, scored at 5-1/2".
- For the front of the card, tear three snow banks from white cardstock, in graduating heights, to be layered on top of one another.
- For the inside of the card, cut a 3-7/8" x 5-1/8" panel from white cardstock along with a 4" x 5-1/4" layer from red cardstock.
- Cut a 1/4" x 5-1/4" strip of red cardstock to be used to embellish the inside panel.

**Step 2. Stamp and die cut:**

- a. Stamp the snowman and three trees on white cardstock and color with choice of markers. Die cut them with coordinating dies.
- b. Stamp front sentiment and star on front of card base in Versamark, apply white embossing powder and heat emboss.
- c. Stamp inside sentiment on white panel and adhere thin red cardstock strip down left side. Adhere white panel on red cardstock layer.



**Step 3. Assemble the card:**

- a. Adhere snow banks, snowman and trees to front of card base. Create background snow if desired with white paint pen.
- b. Adhere inside panel to inside of card base.
