



### Supplies:

- The Project Bin “North Pole” stamp set
- Pool Party cardstock
- White cardstock
- MISTI stamp tool
- Ink
- 3x3 post-it notes for masking
- Corner rounder
- White foam pop up adhesive
- Seam binding
- White Crystal Drops
- Craft glue



### Instructions

#### Step 1: Cut card base, layers and tag pieces:

- a. Create card base from teal cardstock. Standard A2 top fold created here, 4-1/4” x 11” piece of cardstock, scored at 5-1/2”.
- b. Cut front panel from teal cardstock measuring 3-3/4” x 5”.
- c. Cut white panel for inside measuring 3-7/8” x 5-1/8” along with teal layer measuring 3-3/4” x 5” and teal strip measuring 1/4” x 5-1/8”.
- d. Cut teal and white pieces measuring 2” x 2-1/4” to be trimmed down for tags.

**Step 2. Stamp and mask:**

- a. Using the circular cluster of snowflakes in the stamp set, mask off the 'Let it snow' sentiment in the center of the cluster and stamp snowflakes over the entire teal front panel, masking other areas of the stamp as needed to fill in blank areas. You will use quite a few post-it notes. :)
- b. Mask off the right side of the white inside panel, leaving 1/2" border unmasked on the left side. Using the same circular cluster of snowflakes and masking off the sentiment in the center, stamp snowflakes down the left side of the white inside panel.



**Step 3. Stamp sentiments and assemble:**

- a. Stamp the front sentiment on the white cardstock piece measuring 2" x 2-1/4" and then trim both the white and teal pieces down to create tags. Stagger them and adhere them together at the top just beneath the hole.
- b. Stamp the inside sentiment on the white inside panel, adhere the narrow strip down the left side at the inner edge of the masked area, and adhere the panel to the teal layer. Adhere piece to inside of card base.
- c. Adhere foam to the back side of the snowflake panel and adhere to the card front.
